Treasurer's Report:

Bank accounts have been assigned to appropriate representatives. 2019 Taxes scheduled to be filed. All existing bills have been paid and are up to date.

Concession clean up:

Set for 2/5 3 pm pending approval of water winterization. Pest control will be scheduled directly after cleanup.

Refurbishing Helmets:

John Fort presented a budget for 146 helmets send out to be refurbished. Presented alternative plans for new helmets to be purchased.

Equipment Management:

Equipment managers plan to take inventory of all equipment.

Fundraising Opportunities:

All proceeds of fundraisers sponsored by Wildcats will go to Clements Cuties in partnership with "Kids with Cancer".

Annual carwash set for 4/5 at Leonardtown Autozone 10 am-2 pm. All proceeds go to "Kids with Cancer"

NFX:

Flyers have been put out, Ashely will check locations and replenish as needed. Flex has sent permits out for approval.

Grants:

Jon Dobry search and applied for qualifying grants on our behalf. USA football has unfinished business with SMYAC to be looked into by Chrissy.

Bathrooms:

The project manager promised the installation of a bathroom by the start of the season.

Website provider: Sports connect has pricing changes, each transaction will be charged an additional \$3. That fee goes directly to sports connect. President proposed a vote to keep or change.

MAJORITY VOTE: We will stay with the current website provider.

Budget:

Jessica submits the 2020 cheer budget.

Ron notifies the board of projected budgets and limits for the 2020 season.

Clinics:

Leonardtown Wildcats will be participating in local Glazier Football clinics. Glazier offers a league price; allowing all staff to go to any clinics anytime, and access glazier "vault". President proposed vote to pay \$500 toward League-wide glazier clinics.

Raffles:

Noodles presented pre-approved sportsmanship raffle. 200 tickets sold at \$10 each. Drawing will be held 3/12/2020

Fishing Boat raffle presented. The package costs \$550 and will include a half-day charter boat fishing trip for 6 people, cleaning of fish and a \$50 gift card for refreshments. President proposes a vote to approve raffle for April.

Proposal for purchasing new tackling dummies. One for younger teams One for older teams with 2 "arms" each. This would cost 1025.23. President proposed vote yes or no.
